My objectives are to hit all my deadlines on time that are shown on my Gantt chart and to make sure they are on high standard.


Audience:

Employers/Companies – They are the one who is going to hire me and give me a job so I'll have to show them my skills and what I've done/experience before.


Students – To let them know and encourage them to the course.

Gantt chart




Possible Solutions




Twenty Fourteen

Alternative Solutions

Squarespace

Pros

Cons


- they lack professionally-designed templates






